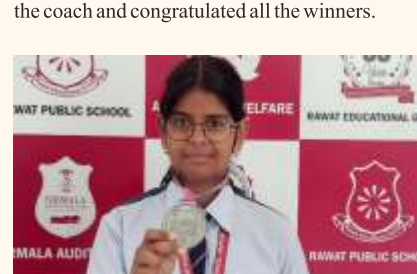
FEATHER OF SUCCESS IN DISTRICT YOGASANA CHAMPIONSHIP

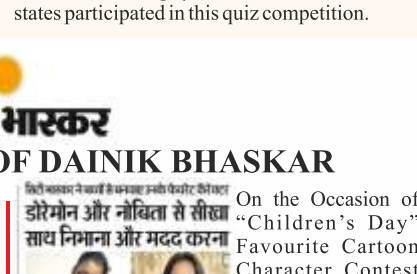
FIRST POSITION IN GROUP SONG CONTEST BY BHARAT VIKAS PARISHAD

COLOURFUL GLIMPSE OF THE ANNUAL FUNCTION 'GULLAK'

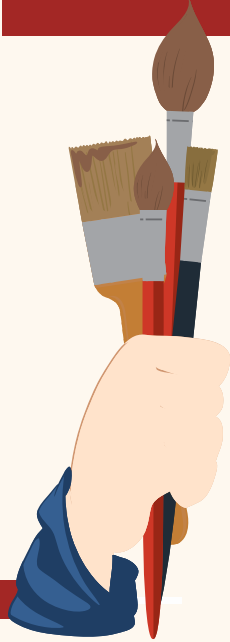

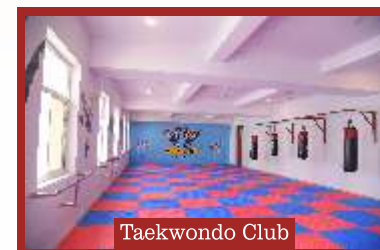
