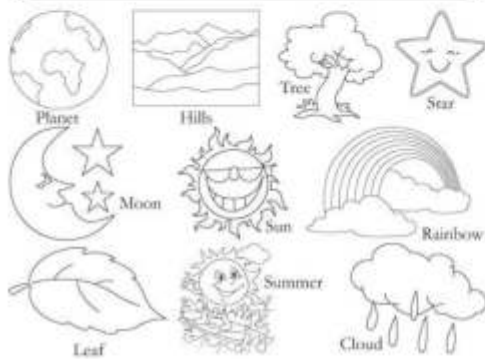
Eco-Friendly Diwali

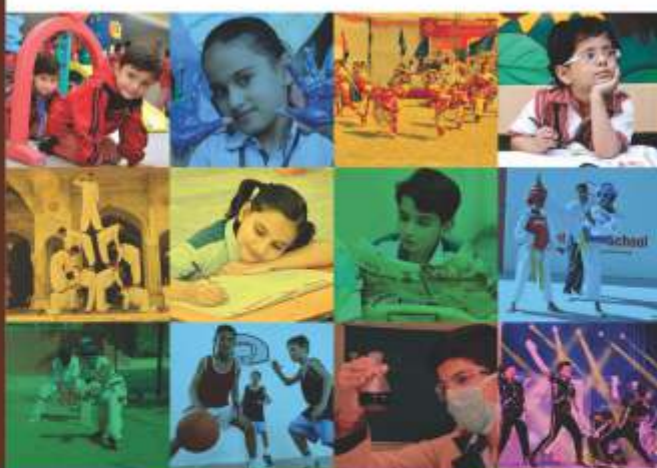
PPL Champions
