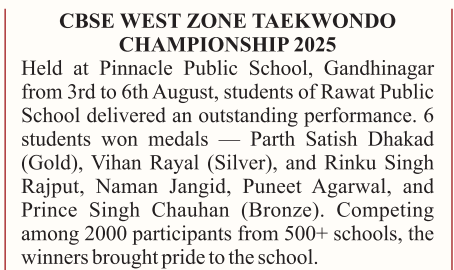

## SPORTS CHAMPIONS SESSION 2025-26



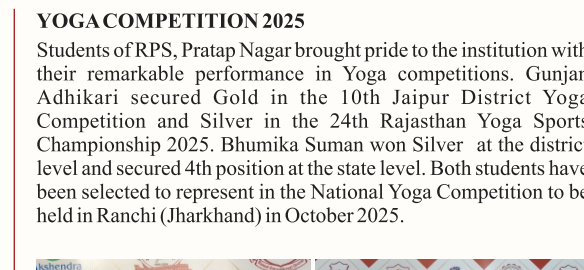
**TSA CUP DISTRICT TAEKWONDO CHAMPIONSHIP-2025**

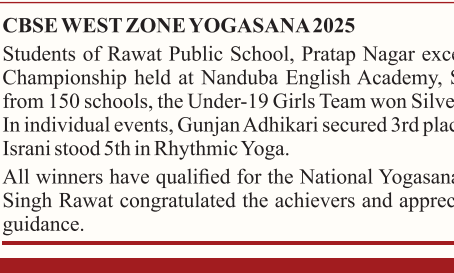
**JOSH-2025**

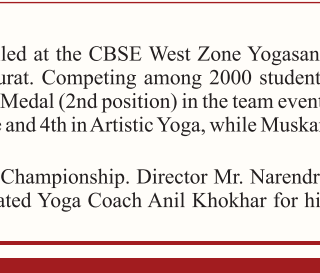
**YOGA COMPETITION 2025**

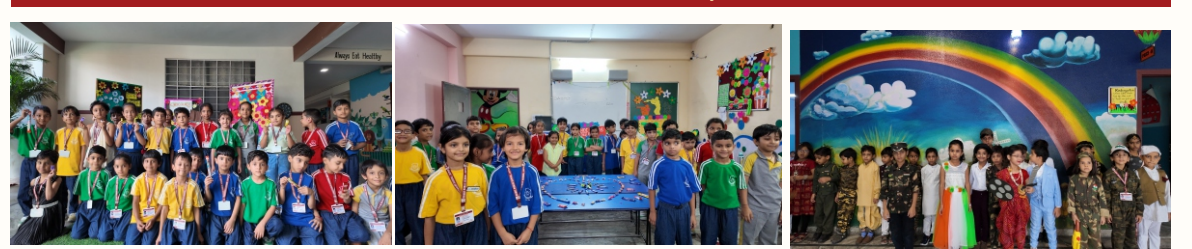

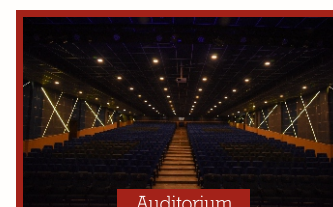
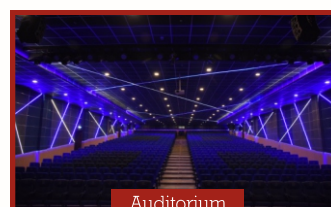
